Playing Activities.

Casual Bowling.

The green is open for individuals to bowl on whenever they chose. However, please remember to check the chalk board within the club house where players can book a rink, perhaps for an internal competition match that may have been arranged and also check that some of the rinks aren't required for league, club, county or national competitions.

Roll Ups (Chummies).

We run two informal sessions (social) during the week. On a Wednesday morning, at approximately10.15am and a Friday evening at 4.00pm. Even if the weather is unkind, players still meet up for a quick cup of coffee and a chat. There is no dress code for these sessions, with the emphasis on 'informal' but flat-soled shoes must be worn,

Friendly Bowling.

The club has a comprehensive season of friendlies against local clubs (home and away) most Saturday afternoons, largely with a 2.00pm start (but occasionally 2.30pm start). We also have a number of Wednesday evening friendlies (6.00pm start) throughout the season, where we meet and play old and new friends.

Internal Club competitions.

We run a number of internal club competitions both on an individual basis and a team basis. All competitions are on a knock out basis, with all matches taking place over the season, on dates agreed between the players. The finals of these competitions are held on a "final's day" at the end of the bowling season.
